### Future U3A Activities

Those shielding in Wales are effectively still in lockdown until 16th August. We are not yet able to have any face to face meetings in doors, are not permitted to mix outside of certain “family bubbles” and the 5 mile travel restrictions will not be reviewed until 6th July.

Even when we are able to institute outside activities, social distancing and the recording of those participating in any U3A group activities will need to be recorded for track and trace purposes.

Our main meeting place, The Metropole is still closed. The Metropole management will tell us if and when conference facilities are re opened.

In view of all the above the Committee have decided there will be no formal large speaker meetings of our U3A until at least October and that date will be reviewed on the basis of unfolding information. Please will you pass this on to other U3A members who may not receive the Newsletter.
